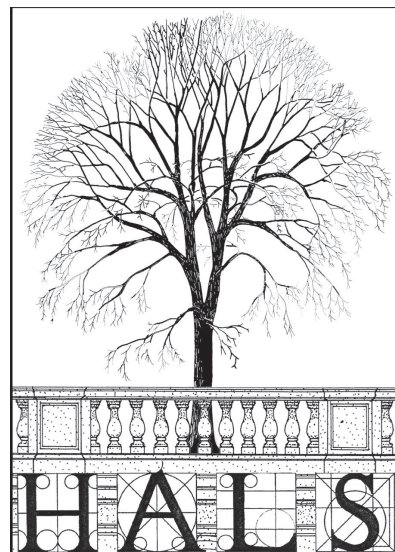

## Discussion Items:

**2. Inventory:** Divide inventory list up into categories based on significance, status (threatened), size, location, etc. so that anyone interested in doing a documentation can easily search for a site that is interesting to them.

**3. Outreach:** Reach out to allied professionals and

associates to generate interest in HALS and build relationships that could lead to team efforts on documentations.

**4. HALS documentation projects:** What is currently being worked on and where there is an active interest in documentation.

**5. 2019 HALS Challenge:** Historic Streetscapes, Short-Format, due July 31, 2019.
